## General Information

The Mangochi area is historically important to the nation as well as the Yao people, who reside in this area since the pre-colonial era. Mangochi, as explained by the Yao people means Mgoji, a rope and signifies the area where Yao immigrants were bound together and formed a strong community. In 1891, the colonial government built Fort Johnston in the Mangochi area. It was established to protect British interests. Due to the establishment, Mangochi became an important place and was commonly known as the Fort Johnston District but was changed back to its original name after the Malawi became independent.

Mangochi is the closest town and will give its visitors a authentic cultural fishing village experience. On this half day tour you will explore the towns basic elements of shopping, transportation and living in a rural African town. Stroll across the market and purchase a variety of local products and souvenirs. Are you interested in speaking to locals and find out more about their daily lives? This is your chance to do so!
