General Information

The Mua Mission is the most important cultural heritage site in Malawi. It is historically important to the Chewa people, as it is the traditional home of their priestess Mwali and their king Karonga. Today, Mua is the capital of the MasekoNgoni, which rule the area since 1898. In 1902, a Catholic mission was established by the White Fathers. Mua Mission aims to preserve the area, surrounding flora & fauna, its people and their culture. Its famous wood carvings and paintings are displayed around the world and should not be missed out on. The Kungoni Center, the Chamare Museum, its art gallery and showroom, which presents the Chewa, Ngonu and Yao peoples culture are must-sees. The missions church is unique and famous in Malawi.

The trip includes a packed lunch provided by Makokola that can be enjoyed near the Nadsipokue River that flows though the mission and leads to the Kungoni Falls. Watch the carvers at work and visit the show room. Driving is 1.15 hours one-way. Are you ready to explore Malawi's cultural heritage?
